

2019 Bon Ton Roulet Points of Interest

Sunday, Day 1, July 21, 2019Cortland to Wells College, Aurora

- Departing Cortland ride past Blue Creek, Dry Creek and Fall Creek on the way to the village of Groton
- Ride north from Groton to Locke to the Historic Village of Moravia along OwascoIntlet
- Waterfalls at Filmore Glen State Park
- Scenic West Lake Rd past the southwest end of Owasco Lake
- From the shores of Owasco Lake to shores of Cayuga Lake.
- Travel down the Main Street of Historic Aurora to Wells College

Monday, Day 2, July 22, 2019Wells College, Aurora to Taughannock Falls SP

- South through Genoa and Lansing along Salmon Creek.
- Salmon Creek Falls just north of Lansing
- Stewart Park, Ithaca Farmer's Market, Cayuga Waterfront Trail, Ithaca Children's Garden
- Cayuga Nature Center
- Finish Ride at Taughannock Falls State Park. Take the short hike to see the tallest single drop waterfall east of the Rockies. Catch a sunrise on the shore if you are an early riser.
- The BonTon Triathlon, a modified sprint distance triathlon. This is scheduled so that you can ride and participate in this if you wish.

Tuesday, Day 3, July 23, 2019 Taughannock Falls SP to Watkins Glenn

- Ride along Taughannock Creek through Trumansburg (home of the famous Grassroots Music Festival.)
- North to Interlaken passing by Americana Winery and Bandwagon Farm Brewery.
- Lodi, Hector, Watkins Glen wineries, breweries and distillery galore: Lamoreaux Landing, Wagner Vineyards, Hazlitt Vineyards, Damian Wine Cellars, Two Goats Brewing, Finger Lakes Distilling...the list goes on!
- Seneca Lake Southeast shore, Hector Falls.
- Arrive at Clute Park in Watkins Glen on the South Shore of Seneca.

Wednesday, Day 4, July 24, 2019Watkins Glen to Geneva

- Downtown Watkins Glen
- Watkins Glen, Dresden, Geneva
- Lakewood Vineyards, Barnstormer Winery, Magnus Ridge Winery, Rock Stream Vineyards, Glenora Wine Cellar, Climbing Bines Hop Farm and Brewery, Fox Run
- Kashong Creek and Conservation Area
- Western Shores of Seneca Lake – Belhurst Castle and Winery.
- Lake front part, Geneva, ending the ride at Hobart & William Smith College

Thursday, Day 5, July 25, 2019 Geneva to Geneva

- Phil Fountain Century Ride travels from Geneva, Canandaigua, Bristol, Gorham back to Geneva
- The regular route travels from Geneva, Canandaigua, Gorham and back
- Enjoy Canandaigua, Kershaw park, city pier and view of the smallest state park in NY (Squaw Island)
- Enjoy the beautiful town of Geneva – eateries, historic buildings and idyllic lakeside locale.
- DeLago Casino bus tour provided, \$20 per person. Sign up by calling the Auburn YMCA.

Friday, Day 6, July 26, 2019 Geneva to Emerson Park, Auburn

- Ride takes you along the Montezuma Wildlife Refuge north of Route 5
- Seneca Falls – Central in the Women’s Suffrage Movement and Town in “It’s a Wonderful Life”, Bedford Falls, base off of Seneca Falls.
- Rest stop at the Montezuma Winery
- Cayuga, Union Springs, Fleming
- Emerson Park for camping, swimming and our Bon Ton party!

Saturday, Day 7, July 27, 2019 Auburn to Cortland

- Owasco Lake, through town of Owasco
- Bear Swamp State Forrest
- Over Bear Swamp Creek, Grout Brook, Factory Brook.
- Origins Café in Homer for one last pick-me-up
- Historic Main Street Homer
- Finish the ride back at JM McDonald Center in Cortland.
